Another good year is winding down for the Dawgs, the Board has done an excellent job of keeping Santa Anita Golf Club in the lime light and many players from our Club on the tournament lists with PLGA and SA. We must thank them for their efforts and wish the new Board lot's of luck to continue the course.

THE CHANGE IS ALMOST HERE; In January 2010 for the first time in a generation all of California's fully USGA licensed golf associations will be using the same handicap vendor. GHIN is expected to be fully functional January 4th. Your PLGA number will change to a unique 7-digit GHIN number by placing a "9" in front of your existing 6- digit number. NOTE: You will be unable to post scores between December 22 and January 4, In order to accommodate the changeover the system must be completely shut down for that period. Golfers may keep

track of rounds played during this "posting holiday" and enter them into the new system after January 4. Handicap Revisions will now be twice monthly--- on the 1st and 15th of every month. If you do not currently receive your handicap e-mailed to your E-Mail address, notify the PLGA office of your E-Mail address by sending the office an E-Mail at leloud@covad.net and you will be added to the list.

PLGA has a new Rules and Competition Director as Jim Gonzales was elected to replace Chuck Jorgensen.
